CHINA: BEIJING AND SHANGHAI LABOR BUREAUS ESTABLISH REQUIREMENT CHANGE

Effective Immediately

A new requirement by both the Beijing and Shanghai Labor Bureaus in China have been installed. They are now requiring University Degrees for those applying for new Work permits in Beijing and Shanghai.

Qualifying the applicant using relevant work experience MAY be considered; however, there is **no guarantee** at this time whether this will be an addition to the new regulation and the application could be rejected.

Those holding Work-permits who request a renewal are not currently impacted by this new requirement.
